How do I get started?



- **Register:** Go online to www.KidsHelpingKidsSeattle.org and fill out the “Register Now” Form. Send it to us via email, fax or mail.
- **Request Materials:** We have posters, penny jars, jar labels, a Caspar Babypants song, videos, and other materials to help you promote your drive. You can request materials be mailed to you, or you can visit us at the Wellspring Family Services office and pick them. We’re located at 1900 Rainier Avenue South in Seattle, Monday - Friday 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- **Collect Coins:** Ask family, friends, and neighbors to donate. Consider setting up a collection jar in your neighborhood – at mom or dad’s work, a coffee shop, your gym or a store where you shop (remember to ask for permission first!).
- **Make Delivery:** Come and visit Wellspring Family Services to deliver your donations. Tell our front desk greeters you have a “Kids Helping Kids donation” and we’ll come down to accept your donations.
- **Enter To Win Your Own Caspar Babypants Song by submitting your donation on or before September 1, 2010.**
