It was the first and potentially largest gift to our newly-established Capital Campaign. Yet, we had no idea just how significant this award would become.

Within one year the club personally asked every single member to give to the campaign. The result was more than 700 members – 94% of Seattle Rotary membership – pledging more than \$4.2 Million in personal gifts.

Not only was the financial support of Seattle Rotarians significant, but their advocacy and involvement in the project was priceless. Rotarians helped us with everything from securing State funding in Olympia to developing the new name and new look for our agency, Wellspring Family Services.

Not only did they play a major role in making the Rotary Support Center for Families possible, but with it they sealed the vision to end homelessness for families across our community.
